Stem Cell therapy a boon for patients with heart disease.

Heart transplantation is seen as the final word for any ailment that afflicts the heart. But there is another option available now - Stem Cell Therapy.

Congenital Heart Disease [CHD] is abnormality in the heart's structure that is present at birth. Congenital defects often compromise the heart's ability to pump blood and to deliver oxygen to the tissues of the body. It is estimated that every 15 minutes a baby is born with congenital heart disease*. The stem cells found in a newborn's umbilical cord blood hold great promise in cardiovascular repair.

For this study, stem cells from newborn's with Congenital Heart disease will be collected from the umbilical cord following birth

for Congenital Heart disease typically performed at 4 to 6 months of age -- the stem cells will be injected into the heart muscle.

The cord blood will be sent to tak for processing, where the stem cells will be separated from the
